Choosing plants that are not toxic to horses is the safest bet. The main morphological characteristic distinguishing poison hemlock from water hemlock is the tuberous roots with very distinct partitions in water hemlock [7]. Because they are naturally adapted to survive in a specific climate, the list of specific plants to consider varies dramatically across the country.

Some poisonous plants cause only minor clinical signs, like loose stools. Tawny needles are greenish-yellow on the under surface and have no white stripes. Weeds in pasture can be best described by dividing them into whether they are annual, biennial, or perennial. In Europe, a case involving the large-scale poison hemlock intoxication of calves was reported in the region of Kotel, Bulgaria [13].
